

Conduct at Social Functions

In order that conduct at social functions, such as dances and entertainment, shall be a credit to the school and to the communities of the area, students are asked to abide by the following rules:

1. Students are to do all tasks necessary to planning, preparing, and cleaning before and immediately after the social.
2. Once admitted to the social a student is not to leave and be readmitted.
3. There is to be no smoking in the gym or on the school grounds or property by students unless the activity is open to the general public.
4. All exist areas are to remain free in case of emergencies. Loitering in the lobby is not permitted.
5. All students attending are to behave in such a way as to be above approach by the chaperons. This includes no sitting on the laps of members of the opposite sex, no profanity, no boisterous actions, etc.
6. Mount View High School socials are open only to Mount View High School students. However, parents are always welcome. Exception to this policy is applied in certain specific cases.
7. Students driving cars to and from the social are urged to do so with utmost care. When leaving the school grounds, there should be no tire spinning, horn blowing, or reckless driving.
8. Drinking of alcoholic beverages or involvement with narcotics is positively prohibited. No one has visibly partaken of alcohol or narcotics will be admitted. Any student who has visibly partaken of these and attends a school activity will be suspended from school.
9. Once a student leaves a social he/she must leave the school grounds and general school area. There is positively no loitering in cars during school functions.
10. Good grooming is essential at any social function.
