

### **Student Fund-Raising Activities**

The Board of Directors prefers that the school district support student activities, but it may be necessary for students to raise funds to support some of them. This should be restricted, but if considered necessary, the fund-raising must be approved by the principal and carefully supervised.

The principal must approve fund-raising projects before the activity is initiated. The solicitation of funds is expressly prohibited without consent of the superintendent.

The sale of supplies in the classroom as a fund-raising project for student activities is prohibited.

Parent-teacher committees or faculty-student committees will work in full cooperation with, and under the supervision of the principal in planning any special programs or in conducting any activity, which involves the raising of money.

Parent-teacher organizations will be allowed one approved fund raising activity per year that students (K-6) are involved in.
