

Athletic Eligibility – Mount View Junior High School

All students entering Mount View Junior High School for the initial enrollment, regardless of the grade he/she is entering, will be eligible to participate in athletics beginning the first ranking period in which the student enrolled.

All students must be enrolled and passing all required academic subjects, which are part of their approved academic program. Regular subjects include: mathematics, science, social studies, language arts, and allied arts (health, physical education, art and music).

If, at the time of Progress Reports a student is failing one subject, he/she will be placed on academic probation for two weeks. During that time a student may participate in practices, but may not attend or participate in any athletic contests including exhibition, or scrimmage contests as a member of the team. He/she may attend as a spectator but may not sit/stand with the team during the contest.

At the end of the two week probation period the student athlete must be passing all of the academic classes in order to be removed from academic probation and regain full athletic eligibility status.

Students who fail one subject at the end of the ranking period will be placed on academic probation for a period of two weeks.

If a student is failing two or more subjects at Progress Report time, he/she will be declared ineligible for the remainder of that ranking quarter.

Students failing two or more classes at the end of a ranking quarter will be ineligible to participate in athletics for the ranking quarter following the quarter in which the failures occurred. This would carry over from the fourth quarter to the first quarter of the following year regardless if a student were going to the 8th or 9th grade.

If a student should be placed on Step 4 or higher of the Junior High Discipline Ladder, that student would be placed on probation (same terms as academic probation) until such time as he/she would be placed on Step 3 or lower on the Discipline Ladder. Should the Discipline Ladder ever be discontinued, this provision would be rendered moot.

In order to participate in after-school athletics, including practices, or athletic contests, the student must arrive at school prior to 8:00 a.m. unless he/she has permission from the Principal or Athletic Director
