

Disciplinary Removal of Students With Disabilities

When removing students with identified disabilities from their regular school programs, whether as a result of a suspension, an expulsion, or any other removal covered by state and federal special education laws, it shall be the policy of the District to comply fully with all applicable state and federal special education laws that govern such removals.

The Superintendent of Schools, in consultation with the Director of Pupil Services and other school administrators, may develop and promulgate procedures for implementing this policy, and from time to time, amend those procedures as necessary.
