The Guidance program is designed to help students get oriented to school life, make decisions about their course of studies, resolve personal and social problems interfering with their schooling, assess their educational strengths, weaknesses, interests, and needs, and plan for their occupational, educational, and social future.

The guidance services staff includes special education coordinator, guidance counselors in the elementary school, at the junior high and at the high school, a school social worker, visiting counselors, and specialists in special education.

The guidance counselor is available to talk with students, in confidence, helping them to obtain the information and self-understanding they need to make decisions that will result in personal fulfillment and social usefulness.

A complete and up-to-date guidance library of educational, occupational, and social information will also be available to all students.
